VOLUNTEERS FACTSHEET 2018

Hello! Welcome to the Big Cwtch 2018. We're a two-day charity music and food festival raising money for our headline charity Ski4All Wales, who provide adults with physical, neurological or visual deficit to ski. It's a fantastic cause which makes a huge difference to all those involved.

As a charity event, we don't have any staff, every member of the team gives their time up to create a fantastic festival and raise as much money as we can. We're always looking for extra people to help us make the event happen, whether that be helping with admin work before the event or lending a hand in the car park. If you're reading this then you may well be interested in joining the team! Thanks for reading, we'd love to have you on board.

Below are some of the opportunities we have available covering the build up to and the event itself, along with a little bit of information about what the role entails.

DÉCOR TEAM

Our brilliant décor team help to make the site as beautiful as the local scenery, from hanging lamp shades in trees to covering the site in bunting. This is a fantastic team for the creative amongst you and gives you the chance to see more of the festival. Most of the décor work takes places three to four days before the festival, leaving you free to enjoy the music.

KIDS FIELD TEAM

The Cwtch has lots to keep the big kids and little ones busy. As a member of the kids field team you'll be helping to keep the kids field activities running smoothly. You'll need a lot of energy and a friendly face. The majority of the kids field activities are finished by 7pm so you'll have the evening free to enjoy a great night of music.

BAND LIAISON TEAM

Our brilliant bands need a hand to get their gear on and off stage and to keep the music running. If you've got an interest in events or just want to see how it all runs behind the scenes this could be a great role for you. Our stage management team work really hard to keep everything running but get to experience a unique element of the event.

CAR PARK TEAM

To me, to you - We need friendly, well organised people to help us keep the flow of traffic moving in our car park and assist customers who might need some extra support to access the event. You'll meet loads of people as the first Big Cwtch face our customers see. We'll even provide a super chic high visibility jacket. Car park shifts are usually split up to make sure you still get time to see some of the fantastic music on offer.

BARS TEAM

So, you think you can pull a mean pint? Our bars are the social centre of the event! We need lots of friendly faces to keep the Cwtchers well hydrated. As you'll be serving alcohol you'll need to be over 18 and good with handling cash in a quick paced environment. Bar shifts are also split so you get a chance to see the festival.

CAMPSITE TEAM

How are your tent building skills? If you're a budding Bear Grylls we'd love you to join us helping our campers in the campsite. You'll be the first point of call for all campers, from providing directions to lending a hand with errant canvas.

BOX OFFICE TEAM

Wristband royalty! Our box office team help all of our customers to collect their festival wristbands and provide access information about the event. We need box office bods before the event to help with ticket queries and people on the day to check tickets and welcome our Cwtchers on site. This is a great role for anyone looking for some event management experience.

TRACTOR TEAM

Sometimes the Welsh weather isn't quite what we ordered, in which case we need tractor-trained saviours to lend a hand moving vehicles in our car park. If you know your way around a field and can lend a hand, get in touch.

SITE CREW

If you're a dab hand with a screwdriver and don't mind a bit of mud, the site team could be for you. Our site crew help to keep everything running smoothly across the site. We need site crew the week before, during and after the event so there's plenty of opportunity to get a bit of time to see the music and enjoy the atmosphere.

STEWARDS

Our Cwtch assistants help anywhere around the site, providing a smiley face for our customers to approach if they need help, information or a recommendation for the best flavour of ice cream on site. Stewarding is a great way to see the event as most of the roles involve a bit of walking around the site.

SUPERVISOR

Each of the above teams has a supervisor who takes overall responsibility for that area. Our supervisors are crucial to the smooth running of the event and work incredibly hard before and during the event to ensure that every Cwtcher has a fantastic experience. These roles require a bit more work before the event and are more involved on site, but offer great experience for anyone looking to get into event work.
